



HOME LEARNING POLICY

Rationale:

Home learning at Redden Court School is set to promote personalised learning. When and where relevant or necessary, students may be encouraged to practise or prepare activities to facilitate teaching and learning in all subject areas. Students are expected to undertake independent learning.

Students:

- Must use the school planner to record tasks clearly as directed.
- Must plan their time effectively.
- Will ensure all learning activities are completed to the best of their ability.
- Will realise the necessity of meeting deadlines as an important life skill.
- Must take responsibility for requesting help from the teacher if they do not understand the learning activity, before final deadline.
- Will use the feedback given to improve their progress.

Parent / Guardian:

- Will be encouraged to be involved in the student's home learning by signing the planner on a weekly basis in acknowledgement that home learning has been set and completed.
- Can assist the student's learning by taking an interest in and providing a suitable environment to complete their tasks.

Subject teachers will:

- Ensure that students understand task requirements.
- Explain the exact nature of the task and the deadline for completion.
- Ensure sufficient time is allocated for home learning to be recorded accurately in the student planner.
- Ensure tasks are set appropriate to student's ability.
- Ensure that all home learning will be acknowledged.

Quality and regularity of completing home learning tasks will be reviewed as part of the school monitoring process.
