- I/We will take an active interest in my child's education and will encourage them to achieve and give of their best in all aspects of school life.
- I/We will take part in regular discussions regarding my child's progress and development.
- I/We will keep the school informed of any matters that may affect my child's progress and attitude.
- I/We give permission for photographs to be taken for display and promotional publications.
